## <u>OHS</u>

- New contractors to complete TAC before commencement of work (www.integritynewhomes.com.au/tradecontractorlogin username: subcontractor; password: integrity)
- Provide project manager with SWMS (where required) and general induction numbers.
- Record the products used in the OHS Hazardous Substance Register and leave the MSDS with the Risk Register.
- Ensure that you carry an Australian Standard Compliant, <u>First Aid Kit in</u> <u>your vehicle</u> at all times when on an Integrity site this kit should be construction site & employee number appropriate.

#### **GENERAL**

- All areas to be cleaned thoroughly mechanically and chemically (ie clean off all dags and ensure square corners) before application of waterproofing products,
- Shower hobs are to 65 x 50 Hebel unless otherwise specified on the plans or contract addendum.
- All shower walls to be waterproofed.
- Flanges are to be fitted to all shower plumbing penetrations to AS 3740-2004.
- All waterproofing to comply with AS 3740 2010 and BCA Volume 2 Table 3.8.1.1
- The tile angle to bathroom doors is to be 45mm unless noted otherwise on the engineering/architectural plans. Ensure tile angle is installed level – pack/caulk if required.

# **FINISHING**

	Provide a fact sheet for the tiler which nominates the glues which are compatible with the waterproofing product used. Leave this in a prominent location onsite.
	Call certifying authority and book inspection.
	Clean out job and sweep before leaving.
	Ensure that when you leave the house is secure. If not, you will be liable for theft and any damage that may be caused.
	Provide certificate certifying that the waterproofing has been completed in accordance with the BCA and Australian Standard.
	Complete and sign Integrity Edge and submit with invoice at end of job.
